Dear Senior Parents,

Commencement for the Lakota West High School's Class of 2007 is soon approaching. I want to congratulate you and your children on the honor they have earned and will receive on June 2, 2007.

Commencement will again be held at Millett Hall on the campus of Miami University this year at 2:00 p.m. Miami University offers a facility that provides us with both adequate seating and parking. It also presents us with a great area to take pictures before and after the ceremony. **In addition**, as you know we are using custom gowns again this year. This gown will have a more formal look and the rental cost is the same as the cost for purchasing a gown as was past practice. Due to the fact that the gowns will be rented and need to be returned, we will be allowing parents to decide when they wish to return the gown. **Your son/daughter may choose to return the gown at the conclusion of the ceremony and will then be given his/her diploma.** If you choose to keep the gown for the weekend, you may do so, but we request they be returned no later than **Friday, June 8**, which is the end of the following week. Diplomas will be held until the gown is returned. **There will be no diplomas given during the ceremony.** Graduates will be given a diploma cover only.

Our desire is that Lakota West High School's commencement be conducted with a great deal of dignity and respect. Graduation from high school is a moment seniors and their parents anticipate with much eagerness – a moment they will recall for the rest of their lives; therefore, the staff of Lakota West High School has worked hard to plan a commencement worthy of this meaningful moment.

I am seeking your support by asking you to review with your child that commencement is to be conducted as a **ceremony, not a celebration**. With the support of everyone involved, I'm confident you will find the 2007 Lakota West High School commencement to be one in which the entire community can be proud.
